



RESOLUTION No. G-011-2015

A Resolution Recommending to the Officer-in-Charge, BJMP the Declaration of Single Calculated and Responsive Bid and Award of Contract to MICRODATA SYSTEM AND MANAGEMENT, INC. for the SUPPLY AND DELIVERY of Eighteen (18) Units of Satellite Phones through Negotiated Procurement

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology, sought to gain access to communication devices with wide coverage and proven reliability, especially in times of calamities. Satellite phones proved to work during power outages and not dependent upon cell towers.

WHEREAS, in pursuance of this objective, the agency has included in its Annual Procurement Plan (APP) for CY 2015, the acquisition of (18) units of Satellite Phones to be distributed in all (18) regions;

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group with members of the BJMPBAC conducted a series of meetings and a pre-procurement conference to assess the readiness of the procurement activity;

WHEREAS, the Invitation to Bid (ITB) for the Supply and Delivery of Eighteen (18) Units of Satellite Phones under Bid Reference No. G-2015-011 was published at Phil GEPS (Annex "A") and BJMP websites and at the Logistics Bulletin Board (Annex "B") to invite interested bidders to undertake the project, as well as to request the presence of observers and representatives from the Commission on Audit and Department of the Interior and Local Government (Annex "C").

WHEREAS, during the pre-bid conference (Annex "D") held last 15 July 2015, aside from the representative of one (1) prospective bidders, in attendance had also been the representative of the Commission on Audit,;

WHEREAS, on the opening of bids (Annex "E") which was held on 29 July 2015, the BAC declared the **first failure of bidding**. Three (3) prospective bidders purchased the bidding document, but none submitted a bid nor any manifestation pertaining to their initial interest to participate.

WHEREAS, during the pre-bid conference of the Rebidding (Annex "F") held on 14 October 2015, only observers from the COA, One Commerce Int'l Corp., Smart Communication, Fullbar Communication Systems, Inc., RJEN Innovative IT Solutions and Tremendous Communications, Inc. were in attendance. No bidder was present.

WHEREAS, during the submission and opening of bids (ANNEX "G"), on 28 October 2015, only one bidder, SMART Communications submitted a bid.

WHEREAS, the bid was declared as "Late" as the lone bidder was not able to meet deadline for submission of bids.

WHEREAS, the BAC decided not to accept the bid therefore declared a **second failure of bidding**;

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group conducted the mandatory review of terms, conditions, specifications, and cost estimates of the project.

WHEREAS, by virtue of the failure of the two duly-conducted public bidding, and after the satisfaction of the requirement under Section 53 of the IRR of RA9184, Negotiated Procurement was undertaken for the acquisition of (18) Units of Satellite Phones;

WHEREAS, the BAC made publications in the PhilGEPS, PhilStar (newspaper of general circulation), BJMP website and conspicuous places to invite legally, technically and financially capable suppliers to ensure fair competition (Annex "H"). Five (5) suppliers were also invited to join the negotiation;

WHEREAS, a pre-negotiation conference was held last 14 October 2015 (Annex "I") wherein representatives from one (1) prospective bidder- Smart Communication and observers from the DILG were also present.

WHEREAS, letters of invitation to negotiate had also been sent to RJEN Innovative IT Solutions, Tremendous Communications, Inc, We are I.T. Phils., Inc. (WIT), and MicroData System and Management., Inc.

WHEREAS, during the conduct of Bid Opening held on 14 December 2015 (Annex "J") only one (1) bidder, MicroData System and Management, Inc. submitted a bid proposal.

WHEREAS, after the TWG evaluated the eligibility and technical components of the lone bidder, the BAC declared the lone bidder to be compliant;

WHEREAS, MicroData System and Management, Inc. on its part submitted a bid security in the form of Bid Securing Declaration. The bid amounts to EIGHT HUNDRED NINETY-NINE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO PESOS AND SEVENTY-TWO CENTAVOS (PHP 899,982.72) or (PHP 49,999.04/unit).


WHEREAS, the bid of MicroData System and Management, Inc. passed the Eligibility, Technical and Financial Components, thus it was considered by the BAC to be subjected to Post-Qualification procedures;


WHEREAS, during the conduct of the post-qualification, all authenticated documents submitted were verified and found to be the same as with the originals in the possession of the contractor;


NOW, THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises, the BJMP-NHQ Bid and Awards Committee resolves as it hereby resolved to declare **MICRODATA SYSTEM AND MANAGEMENT, INC.** as the single calculated and responsive bidder and to subsequently award the contract for the **SUPPLY and DELIVERY** of (18) **UNITS** of Satellite Phones at its submitted bid price.
