Prospective bidders should have experience in undertaking a similar and related project within the last two (2) years with an amount of at least fifty percent (50%) of the proposed project for bidding and have the key personnel and equipment (owned, leased or under purchased) available for the prosecution of the project. Bidders or its representatives should have technical knowledge presenting any Identifications of his/her qualifications.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criteria as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA9184) otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act. Subject to exceptions stated in this Bidding Documents, only bids from bidders who pass in eligibility check will be opened. The bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall advance to the post-qualifications stage in order to finally determine its responsiveness to the technical and financial requirements of the project. The contract shall then be awarded to the lowest calculated responsive bid (LCRB) who will be determine as such during post qualification.

All particulars relative to Eligibility Statement and Screening, Bid Security, Performance Security, Pre-Bid Conference, Evaluations of Bids, Post Qualifications and Award of Contract shall govern by the pertinent provisions of RA 9184 and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).
