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BJMP BAC Resolution No. G-2017-006

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE CHIEF, BJMP THE DECLARATION OF THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPOSIVE BID AND AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BATONS (RE-BID)

WHEREAS, the BJMP have programmed the annual procurement of Batons to augment the standard personnel issuances especially to personnel performing custodial and escorting functions;

WHEREAS, the BJMPNHQ-BAC conducted pre-procurement conference to assess the readiness of the procurement activity;

WHEREAS, the Invitation to bid (ITB) for the procurement of Supply and Delivery, of 300 units of Batons under Bid Reference No. G-2017-005 with an **ABC of Php 500,000.00** was published at Phil GEPS (Annex "A"), BJMP websites and at the Logistics Bulletin Board (Annex "B") to invite interested bidders to undertake the project, as well as to request the presence of observers and representative from the Commission on Audit and the People Power Volunteers for Reform (Annex "C");

WHEREAS, a pre-bid conference on this project was conducted on March 28, 2017 with the presence of representative/s of the prospective bidders and observers from Commission on Audit and People Power Volunteers for Reform. Said conference yielded positive responses from the prospective bidders and likewise, the TWG of this project have answered various questions and clarifications and requests for clarifications to address fully the concerns of the prospective bidders on this project;

WHEREAS, submission and opening of bids (Annex "D") was held on April 10, 2017. **Shooters Guns and Ammo Corporation** and **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint** respectively submitted bidding documents. After the initial evaluation, the TWG found all legal and technical components to be compliant to the requirements of this project and thereby declared as eligible;

WHEREAS, financial documents submitted by the bidders were also evaluated by the TWG and found **Shooters Guns and Ammo Corporation** to be compliant and have passed all necessary requirements of this project with a bid offer amounting to Php 438,480.00 and posted a Bid Security in a form of Mangers Check amounting to Php 10,000.00 (BDO Check no 0003673. On the Other hand, the TWG found that the submitted financial document of **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture** is intended for the Supply and Delivery of 250 Units of Handcuffs with a bid offer amounting to Php 390,000.00 and posted a Bid Security in a form of Bid Securing Declaration. Thus, the TWG called the attention of the representative of **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture** to verify their submitted document and subsequently affirmed with the findings of the TWG;

WHEREAS, the Chairperson, BAC informed the Bidder that they are given 3 days to submit their Request for Reconsideration (RR) while their documents remain in the custody of the BAC. The bidders replied that they will file a Request for Reconsideration;

WHEREAS, BAC members, TWG and Secretariat and with the presence of Representatives from Commission on Audit and People Power Volunteers for Reform conducted a meeting on May 25, 2017 (Annex "E") to address and decide on the request for reconsideration filed by **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture**, due to inconsistency entry in their bid form, which was read as "Supply and Delivery of 250 units, cartridge handcuffs..." where it should be read as "Supply and Delivery of 300 units of baton...";


WHEREAS, the TWG adheres to the provision of Section 24.4 of the 2016 Revised IRR RA 9184 that the determination of eligibility of prospective bidders shall be based on the submission of documents enumerated in the bidding document. It further provides that the determination of eligibility shall be through an examination of the completeness of each prospective bidder's eligibility requirements or statements against a checklist of requirement using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria wherein the BAC merely check for the presence or absence of he required documents. A prospective bidder is declared to be "eligible" for a particular requirement if such document is present, complete and patently sufficient; otherwise, the absence incompleteness or patent insufficiency of a requirement will result to a prospective bidder's ineligibility to bid.

WHEREAS, the eligibility of the prospective bidder is not so much dependent on the caption of their bid form but rather on its substance- the completeness and sufficiency of the eligibility requirements. Thus, the TWG recommended to the BAC that the motion for reconsideration of **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture** shall be approved;

WHEREAS, the BAC concurred with the recommendation of the TWG and advised the TWG to notify the bidders of the decision of the BAC and proceed to the conduct of Post-qualification process;

WHEREAS, the TWG conducted Post-qualification process to **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture**, having offered the lowest calculated bid and found the said bidder to be compliant and have passed all necessary requirements of this project and recommended to the BAC the declaration of **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture** as the lowest **calculated and responsive bidder**. Thus, the BAC adheres to the recommendation of the TWG and thereby declared **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture** as the **lowest calculated and responsive bidder** for the Supply and Delivery of 300 Units of Batons.


NOW THEREFORE, THE BJMP BAC RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to recommend to the Chief, BJMP the declaration of lowest calculated and responsive bid and to award the procurement of aforementioned project to **Arm Scor Shooting Center-Espineli Joint Venture** in the total amount of **Three Hundred Ninety Thousand Pesos (Php 390,000.00)**
