**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE CHIEF, BJMP THE DECLARATION OF SINGLE CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER AND AWARD OF CONTRACT TO DIAMOND MOTOR CORPORATION FOR THE SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF TWENTY-TWO (22) UNITS PRISONER'S VAN FY 2018**

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology published its Invitation to Bid (ITB) on the Supply and Delivery of Twenty-Two (22) Units Prisoner's Van at the PhilGEPS on November 30, 2017 with BJMP IB No. G-2018-01, likewise posted at the BJMP National Headquarters Bulletin Board and was also published on a newspaper with nationwide circulation with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to **Twenty-Two Million Pesos (Php22,000,000.00)**.

**WHEREAS**, a Pre-Bid Conference was held on December 8, 2017, 10:00 a.m. at the BJMP NHQ Conference Room, 144 Mindanao Avenue, Project 8, Quezon City;

**WHEREAS**, the Opening of Bids was held on December 20, 2017, 10:00 a.m. at the same address stated in the preceding paragraph. The Bid Opening was attended by members of the BAC, BAC Secretariat and BAC TWG, with the presence of the following bidders: (1) MCX International, Inc.; and (2) Diamond Motor Corporation;

**WHEREAS**, despite sending invitation letters to the Observers, the Commission on Audit (COA), the People Power Volunteer for Reforms (PPVR) and the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industries (PCCI) to witness the opening of bids, they were not able to send their representatives;

**WHEREAS**, based on a non-discretionary pass-fail eligibility criteria, below is the result of the opening of bids:

MCX International Inc.		The BAC declared MCX International Inc. as INELIGIBLE due to the absence of Joint Venture Agreement between their company and Mitsubishi. Since the company's representative informed the Committee that they will be offering Mitsubishi vehicles for this project, hence, this requirement. Note: the BAC required the presence of JVA since MCX International Inc. is fabricating bodies of vehicles only and not the whole vehicle unit, to which the Procuring Entity intends to procure.	The Bidder raised their intention to file a Request for Reconsideration regarding the matter within three (3) days as the required timeline by the BAC.

**WHEREAS**, on December 27, 2017, the BJMP-NHQ BAC resolved to deny the letter of reconsideration of MCX International Inc. for the supply and delivery of 22 units prisoners van FY 2018 in its Resolution No. G-2017-045 (Annex "A");

**WHEREAS**, below is the result of the opening of financial documents of Diamond Motor Corporation:

**WHEREAS**, the BAC through the assistance of its Technical Working Group proceeded to conduct the post qualification process of Diamond Motor Corporation being the declared Single Calculated Bidder;

**WHEREAS**, on January 15, 2018, Diamond Motor Corporation was found to be compliant with all the requirements stated in the bidding documents, thus found to be responsive;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility/technical and financial requirements and based on the result of Test Parameters for the prototype prisoner's van for the supply and delivery of 22 units, prisoner's van, Diamond Motor Corporation, being the Single Calculated Bidder was found to be responsive thus post-qualified;

**NOW THEREFORE**, in view of the forgoing premises, We, the Members of the BJMP-NHQ Bids and Awards Committee **RESOLVE, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to recommend to the Chief, BJMP, the following:


1. To DECLARE Diamond Motor Corporation as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bidder for the Supply and Delivery of 22 units prisoner's van; and
2. To recommend that the Supply and Delivery of 22 units prisoner's van be AWARDED to Diamond Motor Corporation in the amount of Php21,014,294.84.

**UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.**


