Resolution No. G-2017-044

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING TO THE CHIEF, BJMP THE DECLARATION OF LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BIDDER AND AWARD OF CONTRACT TO RILEY CORPORATION FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION OF THIRTY NINE (39) SETS CCTV SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Jail Management and Penology Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) through its Resolution No. G-2017-035 resolved to deny the Motion for Reconsideration of Arrowtek Corporation dated October 18, 2017 after committing a failure in its Technical Eligibility due to the absence of the required Comparative Market Study as stated in the Bidding Documents for the project "Supply, Delivery and Installation of (39) Sets CCTV System (Re-bid)" with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) amounting to **Three Million Seven Hundred Five Thousand Pesos (Php3,705,000.00)**;

WHEREAS, BAC Resolution No. G-2017-035 dated November 2, 2017 also recommends for the issuance of Notice of Lowest Calculated Bidder to Riley Corporation being the next qualified bidder for the project with a bid amount of **Three Million Six Hundred Seventy Six Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Pesos (Php3,676,819.00)**;

WHEREAS, the BAC through the assistance of its Technical Working Group proceeded to conduct the post qualification process of Riley Corporation being the declared Lowest Calculated Bidder;

WHEREAS, on December 7-15, 2017, the demonstration and testing of demo CCTV units submitted by Riley Corporation were conducted at the BJMP National Headquarters witnessed by the BAC TWG and the Company's representatives;

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2017, Riley Corporation was found to be compliant with all the requirements stated in the bidding documents, thus found to be responsive;

WHEREAS, upon careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility/technical and financial requirements and based on the result of the Product Test and Evaluation, Riley Corporation being the Lowest Calculated Bidder was found to be responsive thus post-qualified;


NOW THEREFORE, in view of the forgoing premises, We, the Members of the BJMP-NHQ Bids and Awards Committee **RESOLVE, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to recommend to the Chief, BJMP, the following:

1. To declare Riley Corporation as the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bidder for the Supply, Delivery and Installation of 39 Sets CCTV System; and
2. To recommend that the Supply, Delivery and Installation of 39 Sets CCTV System be awarded to Riley Corporation in the amount of Php3,676,819.00;


UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED.




